

Heart of the Ozarks Junior Angus Association

2019 Undergraduate Scholarship Application

To advance its mission of supporting education, youth and research, the Heart of the Ozarks Junior Angus will award general scholarships to young men and women actively involved in the Angus breed who are pursuing an undergraduate degree. Scholarship award amounts will be determined based on the interest of loans and current years balance availability. Once the application is complete, it will be reviewed by the Heart of the Ozarks Angus Association Scholarship Selection Committee and applicants will be selected for the scholarship award. Applications are due by October 1st, 2019

Applicant Qualifications

1. Applicant must have been an active member of the Heart of the Ozarks Junior Angus for 2 years.
2. Applicant must also have been in good standing with the chapter and performed all required service activities asked of the Junior Association, such a concession stands and banquet participation.
3. The applicant must be a graduating high school senior or must be enrolled in a junior college, four-year college/university or other accredited institution of higher education for the fall term in which the scholarship is to be awarded. Applicants must have a minimum 2.0 GPA (accumulative) to be eligible.
4. The applicant cannot have reached their 21st birthday prior to January 1 of the year of application.
5. The scholarship must be applied to undergraduate studies and is applicable to any field of study.
6. If selected to receive a scholarship by the Heart of the Angus Association Selection Committee, the scholarship applicant will be required to verify their enrollment in an institution of higher education by September 30 before the scholarship award check can be issued. Failure to meet enrollment requirements will result in forfeiture of the scholarship.

7. Should the recipient fail to complete at least one semester of full-time enrollment in an accredited or approved institution of higher education prior to June 30, 2020, for any reason, scholarship funds must be refunded to the Heart of the Ozarks Angus Association.
8. Applicants can only receive the scholarship one time.

Instructions for Completing Application

- Your application must include two letters of recommendation. These letters may come from employers, teachers, ag leaders, extension agents, or other community leaders.
- They may NOT include applicant's parents or other members of the family.
- _____ is the deadline for the application and must be submitted to the Heart of the Ozarks Junior Angus Advisor. Applications must be submitted on time to be considered for the scholarship.
- Must include a short essay describing your leadership potential, career goals and ambitions for the future. How will you promote, advocate and support the Angus breed and beef cattle industry in your plans?
